6. By submitting your photograph to UCT RAG you agree to the non-profit use and publication of said photograph by UCT RAG and their sponsors, during the run of the competition and afterwards, also the reproduction in the Fashion Show.

7. Late (submitted after 17 March 2010), incomplete, incorrect or illegible entries will be disqualified.
